

KIRRA

Purpose of this anonymous survey was to find out what was important to the residents and ratepayers of Kawau Island. You did not need to be a KIRRA member to complete the survey.

Full answers to each question are contained within this document.

High level learnings:

- **People don't know what KIRRA delivers or how decisions are made**
- **The role of KIAC (sharing information from and with Council) is important**
- **Using email to share timely information is very important (88% in favour)**
- **70% of respondents aren't seeing value in the KIRRA mooring at Sandspit**
- **Relatively even split between changing committee representation (53%) and leaving it as is - ie whoever has the time (46%)**
- **Topics of the most importance were Environmental (93%), Cultural (83%) Development (78%)**
- **23% of respondents were not KIRRA members, results showing they do not see Kookaburra as important; they donate more to Coastguard; and they hold strong views about the transparency/accountability of KIRRA**

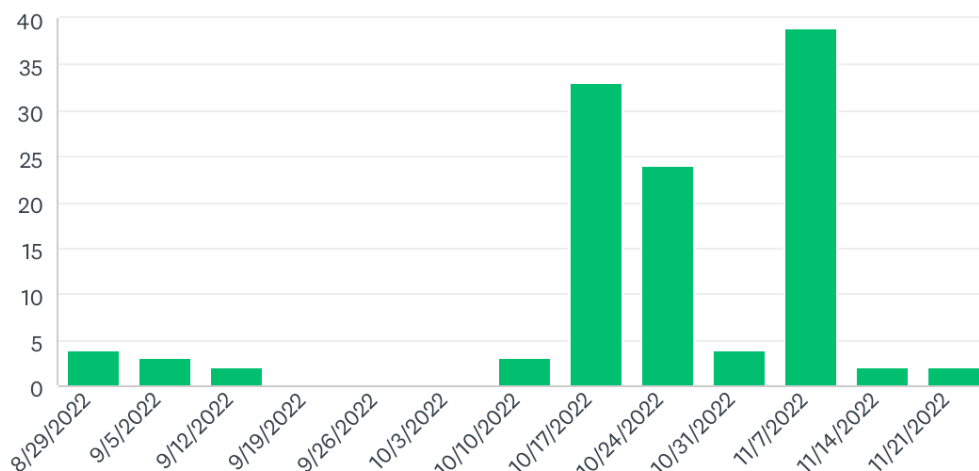
Survey was conducted through SurveyMonkey during Sept/Oct/Nov 2022.

It was run simultaneously with the 'We are Kawau' survey, with this KIRRA survey receiving half the number of responses.

Links to the survey were shared through Kookaburra, Kawau Island Community Facebook Page, posters placed in wharf sheds, email reminders through KIRRA and local island databases, and direct reminders from island 'connectors' (people who easily share information around their own island networks).

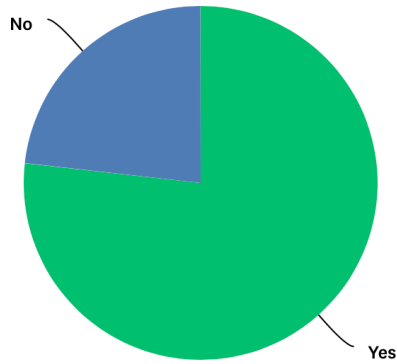
Full responses have been provided in this document, with no analytics undertaken. There was no charge to KIRRA for this survey.

- The below graph showing the responses from email reminders (17/10) and island 'connectors' (7/11)



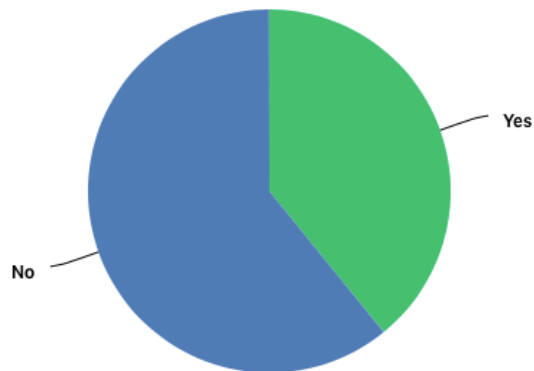
Are you currently a member of the Kawau Island Residents & Ratepayers Association (KIRRA) ?

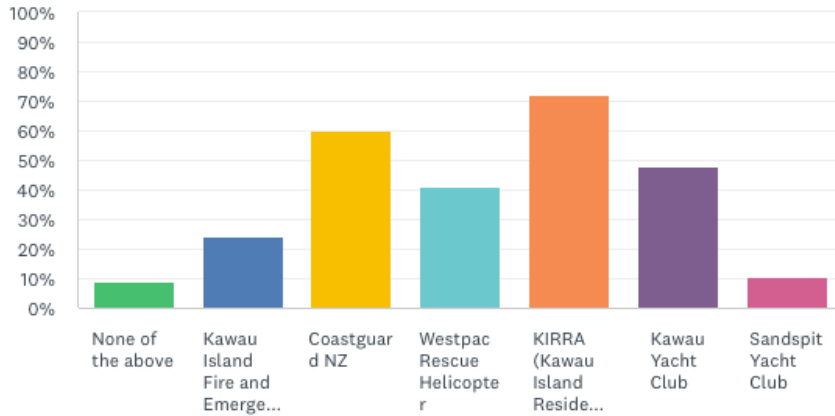
KIRRA currently charges an annual membership fee. Do you know what this money is used for?

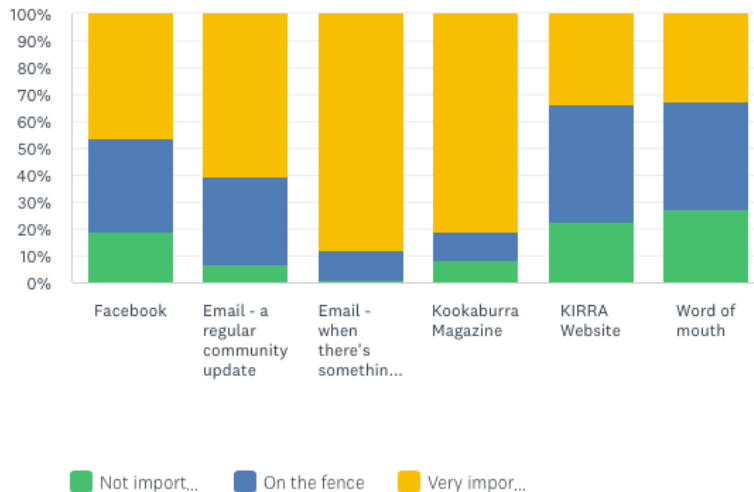

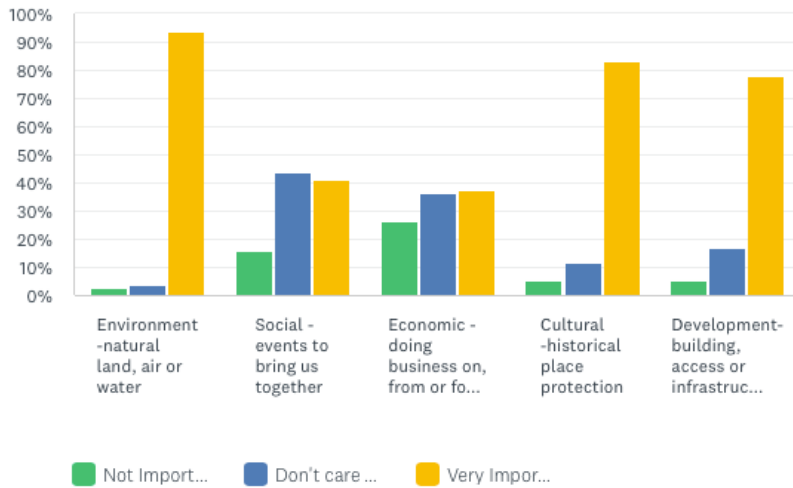

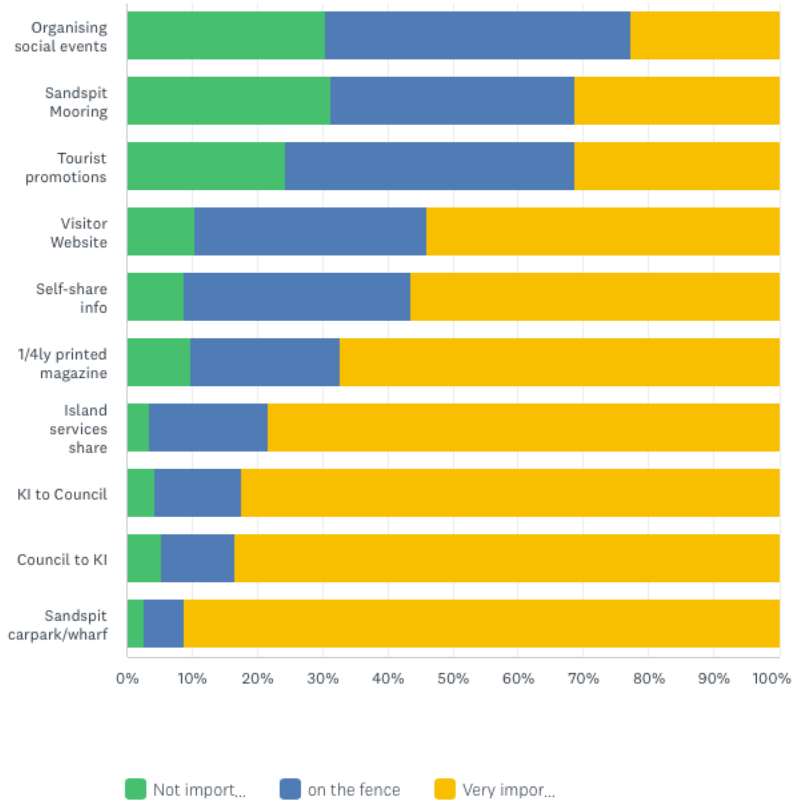
Please tell us what topics are important to you, by ranking the following

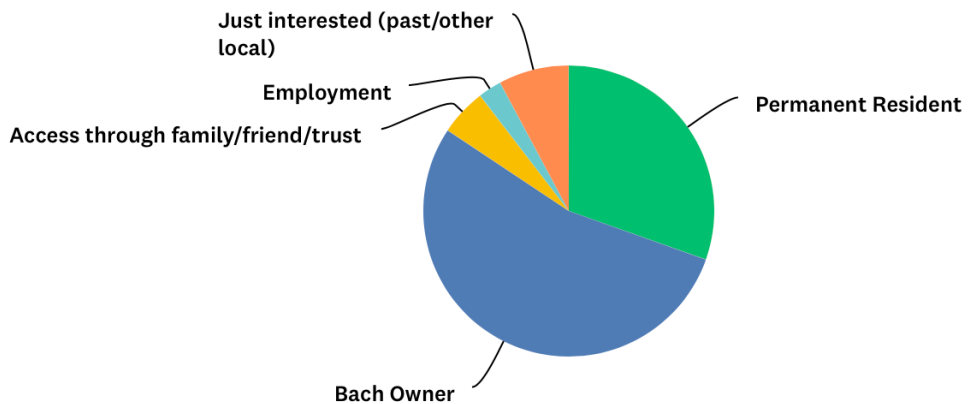
Please rate the importance of the following services to you

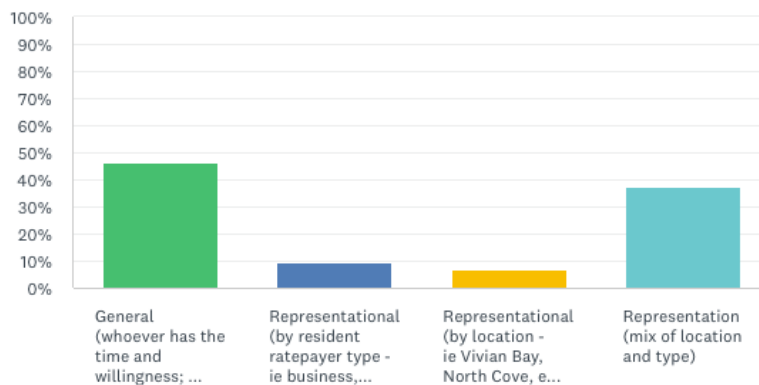

Political issues/representation for island ratepayers and residents - beyond just the local council and in particular where treaty issues may have an impact on owners and residents. 3. If promoting Kawau to tourists is even a good idea?? Infrastructure and pressure on limited resources is already a problem in some places. 4. Depending on 2. above, how/if it is desirable to make more of Mansion House.

The role of KIAC is very unclear and needs more transparency. Are they elected? Whose views exactly are they representing? Are they accountable?

Publication of differing views of wallabies, pest control, etc.

Thoroughly enjoy the KIRRA magazine as my only means of knowing what's going on; like reading the meeting minutes/reports; would see benefit in having more input/opportunitiues towards questionnaires like this.

Active social media presence.

Need to stop Kirra being run by people with their own agendas - there is a large silent majority that do not agree with these agendas - we prefer to do our own thing

Assessment of ongoing energy requirements for the island.

Question 6 providing means for islanders to share things yes, commercial social media platforms that require signup other than kirra, no. It's been a strange few years. I hope decisions about how much people have been able to attend gatherings take this into account. In person meetings away from home can be hard for many these days. It might not mean lack of interest. Much appreciation for what I hope doesn't seem too much like a thankless task.

KIRRA has strayed from being inclusive and positive, to representing a small group whose views are not shared by many who have long associations with the island. this is unfortunate and will take time to rebuild.

Portfolio responsibilities or sub committees that make sense so everyone knows the roles and responsibility on the committee. ie, communications, advocacy, environment...

what about some more information setting out the case for the refresh and the aims it intends to achieve.

Do away with KIAC and have one voice which is the elected body KIRRA, then form sub committees as required for some projects reporting back to KIRRA for the final say

You haven't told me about the refresh....maybe communicate about it :)

Regularly soliciting feedback from residents re what should be mandated to KIRRA to action with priorities and timelines agreed and progress regularly reported on. KIRRA needs to be a proactive and productive group that gets results. This is a big ask for volunteers but is important if the committee is to be relevant and effective. Same goes for KIAC. Thus only people with the time and drive to accomplish something should be on the committees. This capability needs to be established at a formal interview stage for committee members (like other commercially focussed organisations, councils etc)

How to attract more good people onto the Committee

Question 8 is a great question. Yes I think a review is a good idea and I'm on the committee! Would be good to map the island and see where current members are located and then try and coopt a few more members from under- represented bays to ensure good coverage of the island. think there is already a fairly good cross representation of business trust perms etc

The Island should have an island only (non-binding) vote on the future of wallabies. As it is a divisive issue, the vote should be confidential and answered by all islanders and collated by someone unrelated to the island but beyond reproach. The figures should then be publicly released through Kookaburra, web site etc.

Purpose of this anonymous survey was to find out useful demographics about those who call themselves Kawau Islanders.

Full answers to each question is contained within this document.

High level learnings:

- **Low number of permanent residents completed the survey (46)**
- **The majority are not retired - 75% of respondents work (49.26% full time)**
- **55% have a long relationship with Kawau (>16 yrs) with 11% of respondents not currently owning a property on the island (that's high for a survey directed at residents and ratepayers)**
- **93% of respondents have no plans to sell their properties within the next three years**
- **There are more dogs (78) than cats (20) brought to the island**
- **84% identify as European New Zealander**
- **The largest age bracket is 55-64 yrs at 33%; 65+yrs a close second with 30%**
- **When on Kawau, the majority of respondents expect to see Kiwi, Ruru, Tui, Kereru, and Weka**

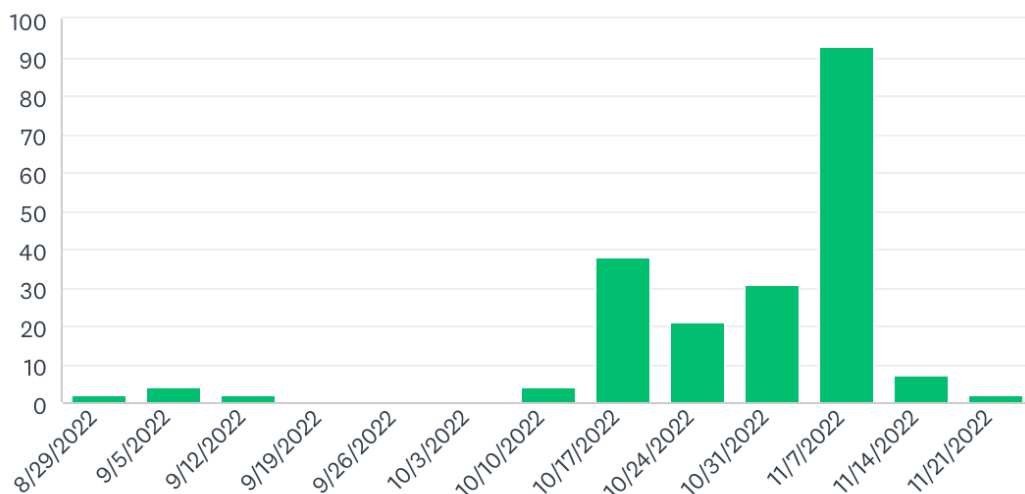
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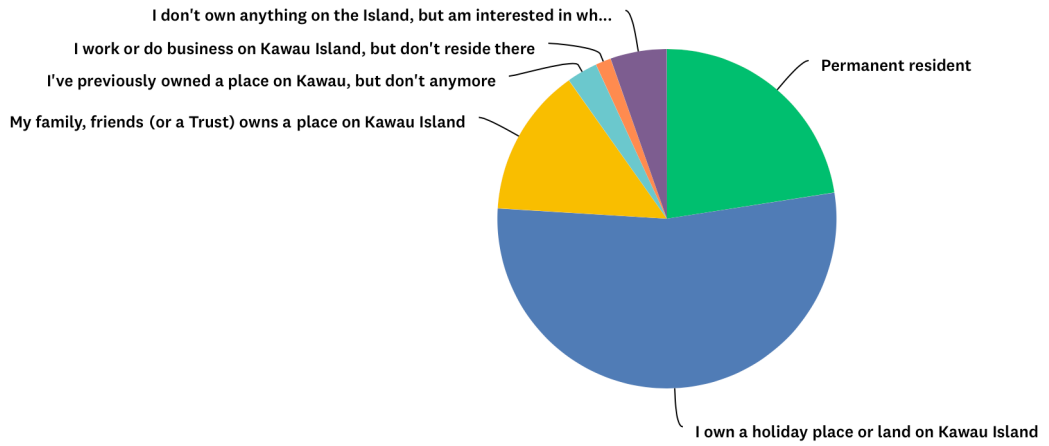
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- 204 people provided answers

- The below graph showing the responses from email reminders (17/10) and island 'connectors' (7/11)



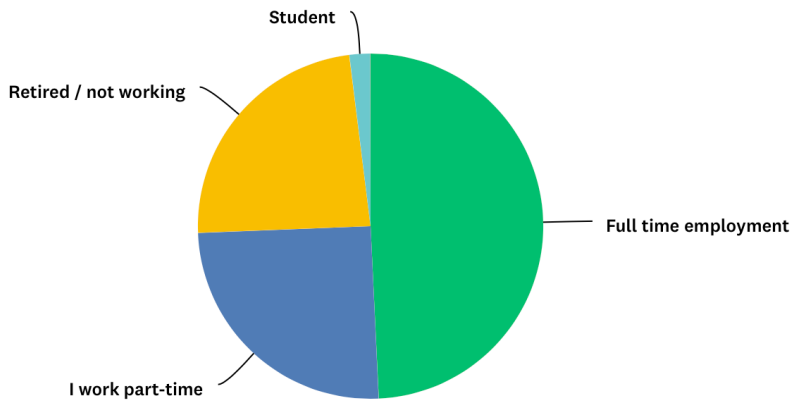

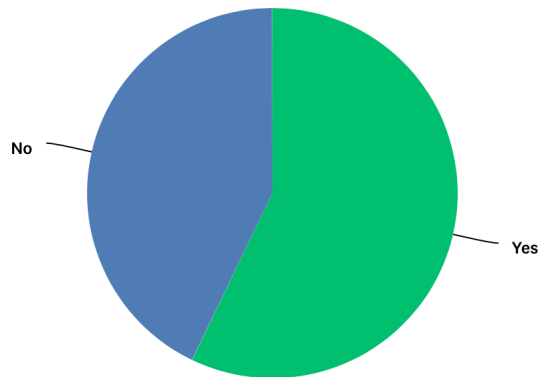

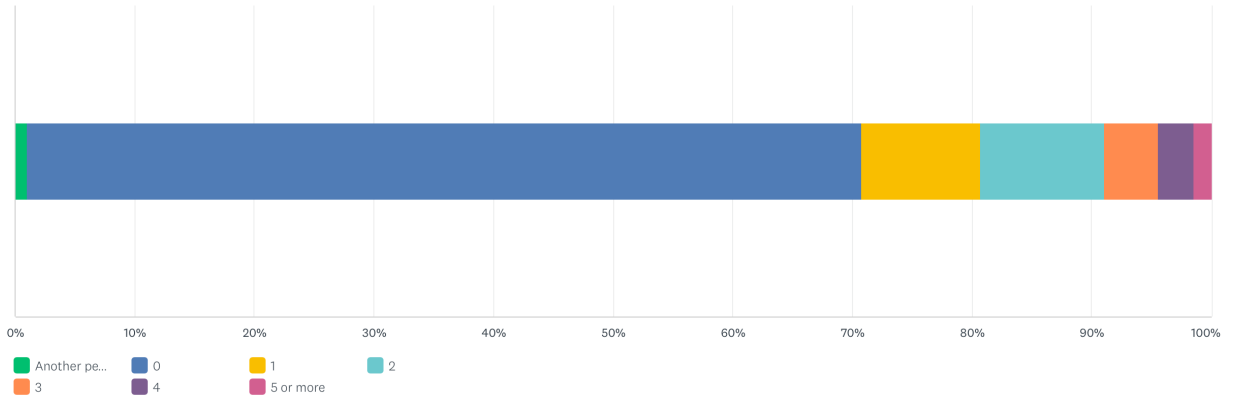
Do you have a vehicle that is kept in the carpark at Sandspit?

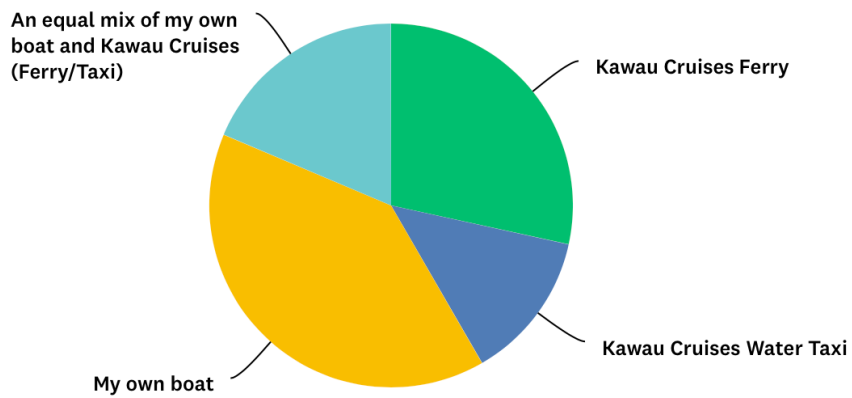
Because children can't officially complete surveys, how many people in your household are younger than 16 years old?

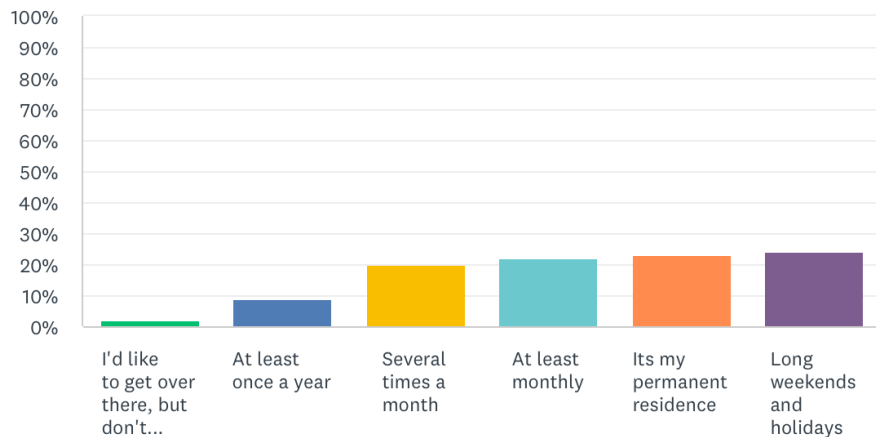
When coming to Kawau, you generally tend to travel by

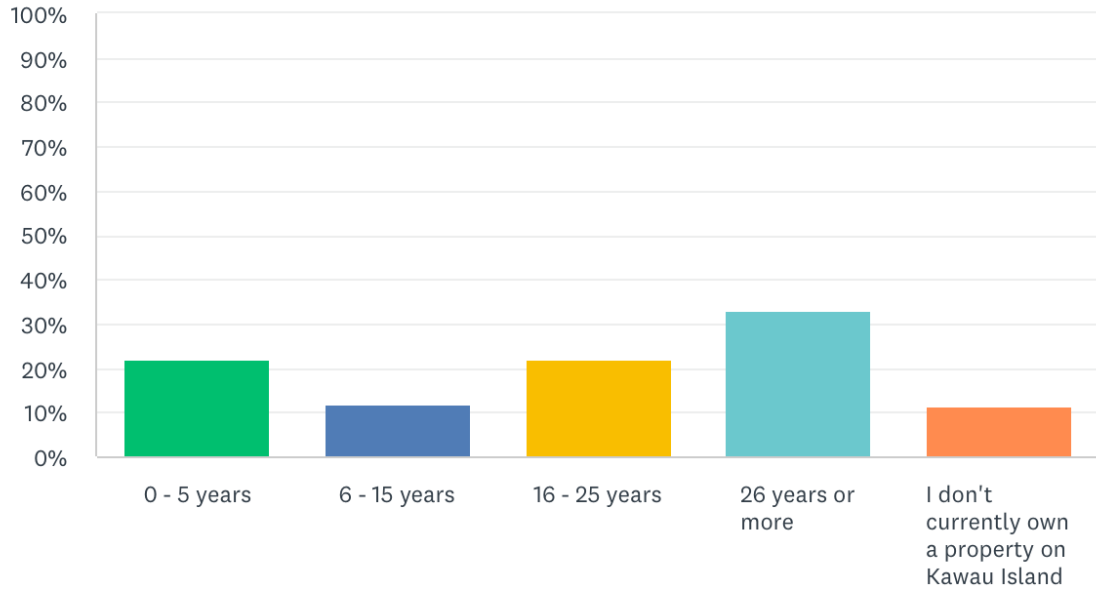

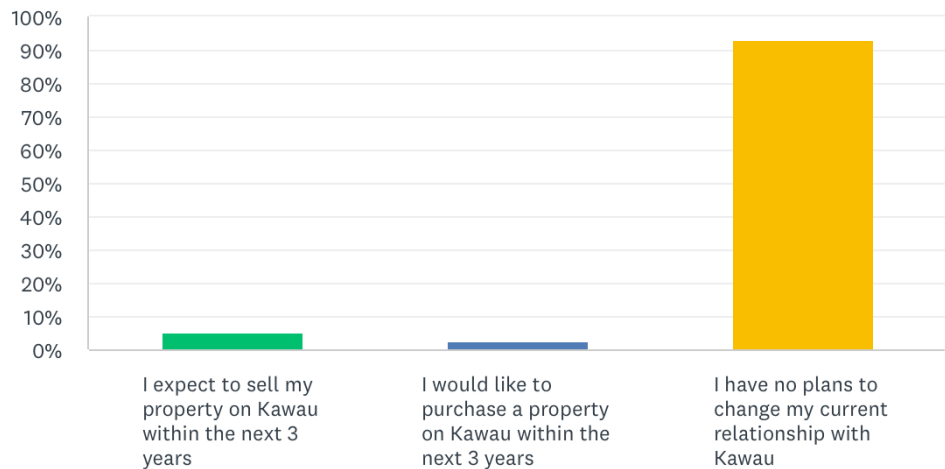

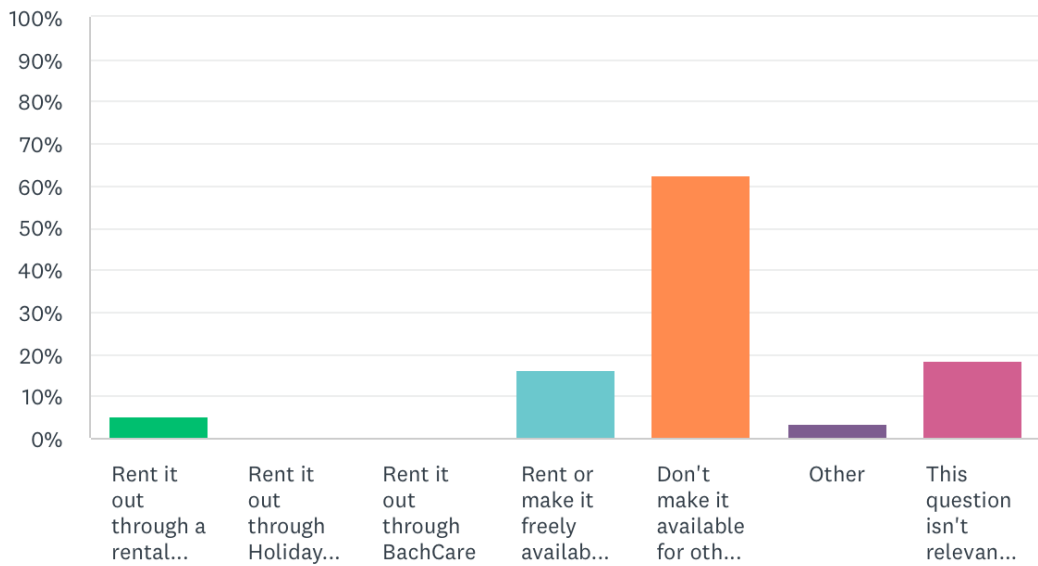

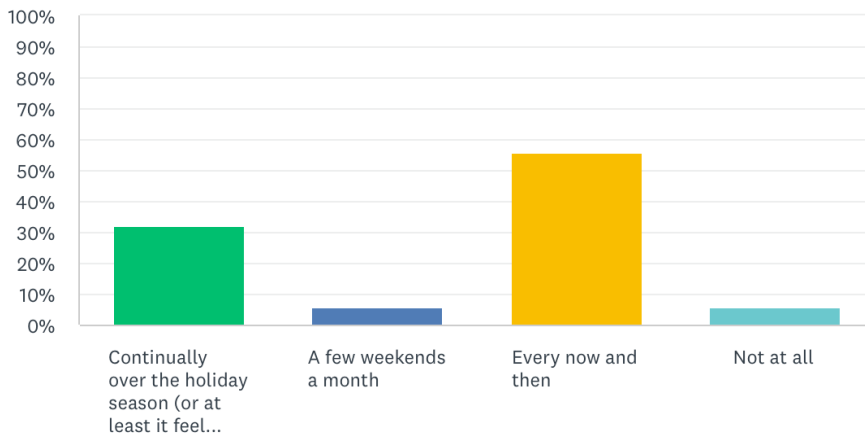

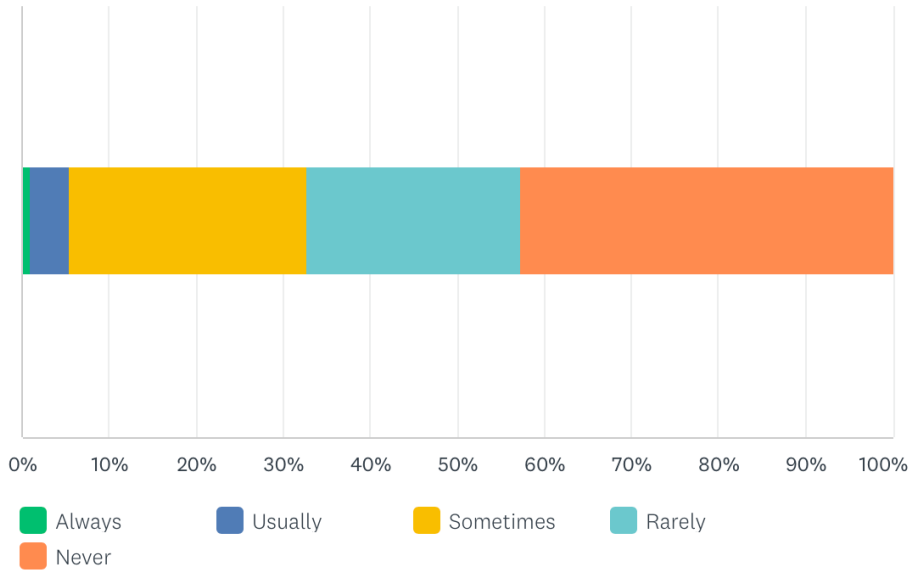

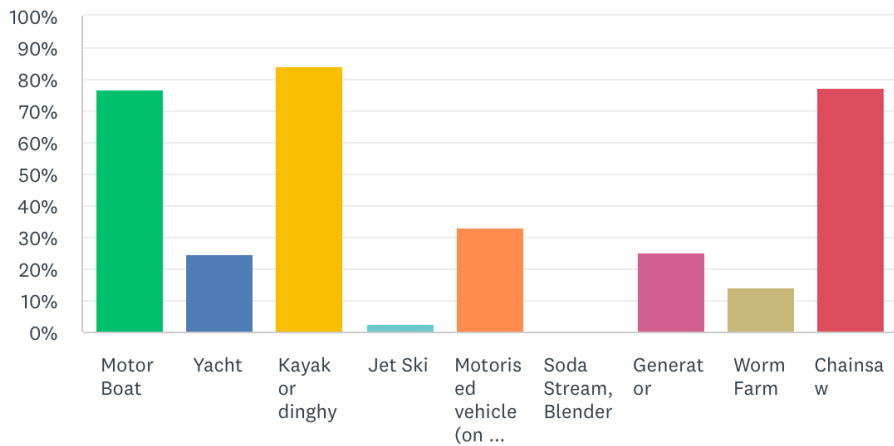

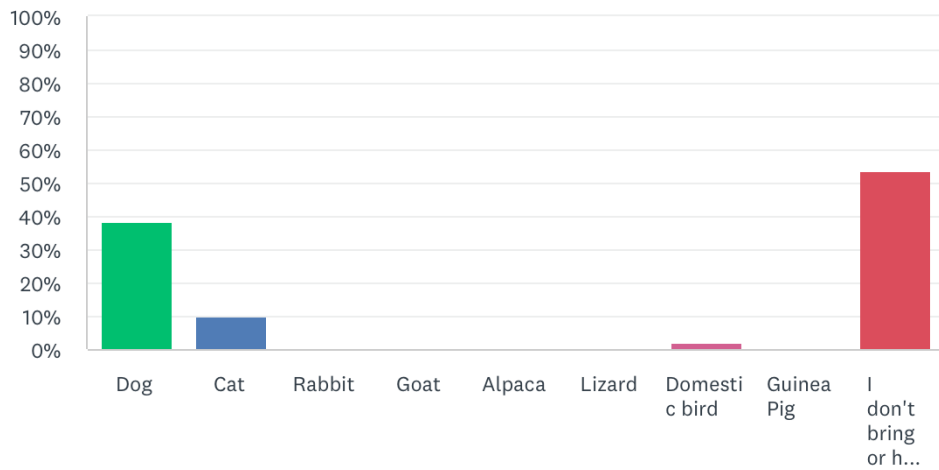

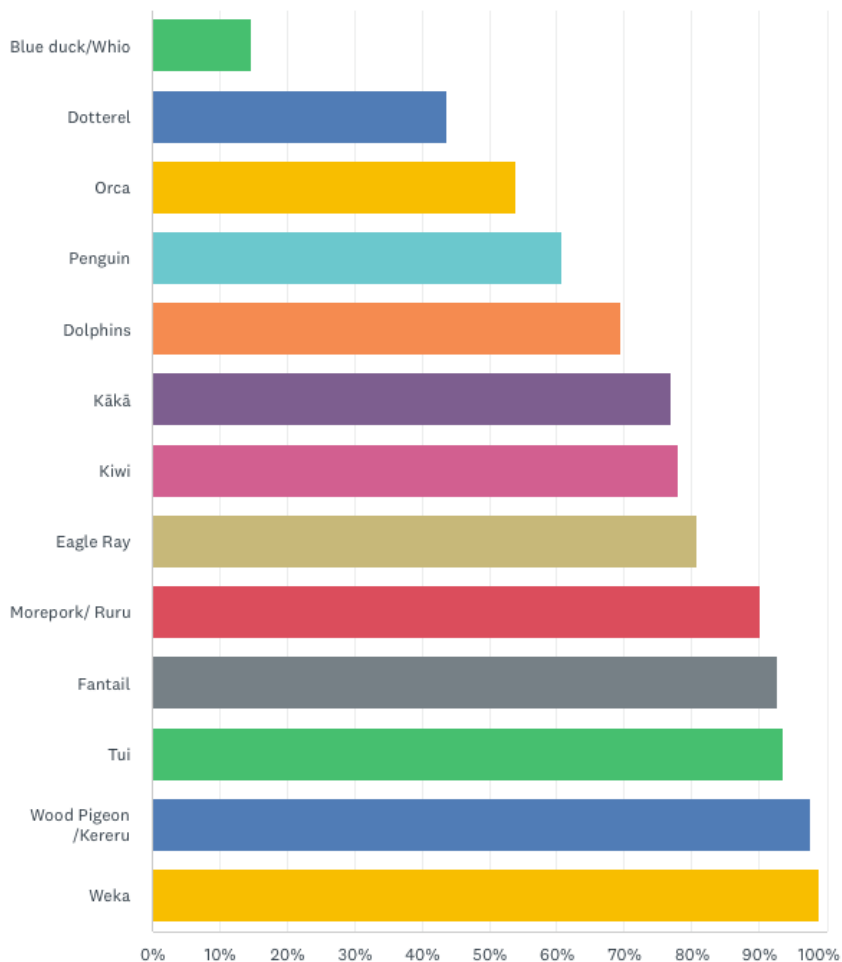

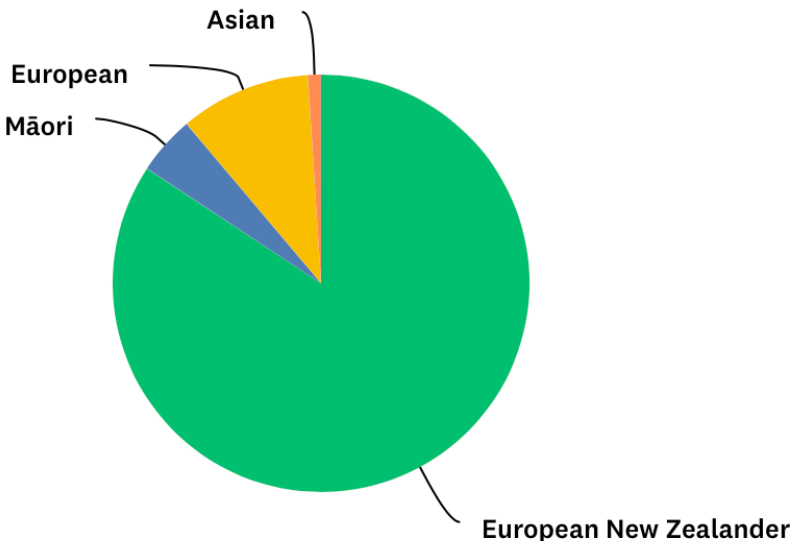
Kawau is graced with wildlife. When on the island, please tick those you currently expect to see or hear:
